

## **CITY OF ALMA PARK RULES**

1. No person shall damage or deface any structure or equipment, real or personal.
2. No person shall make any excavation.
3. No person shall construct or erect any building or structure of any kind, permanent or temporary, or run or string any public service utility line into, upon or across park property except by special permit.
4. No person shall damage, cut, carve, transplant or remove any tree, or injure the bark or pick the flowers or seeds of any tree or plant.
5. No person shall climb any tree, or walk, stand or sit upon monuments, fountains, railings, fences or upon any other property not intended for such purpose.
6. No person shall hunt, molest, harm, frighten, kill, trap, chase, tease, shoot or throw missiles at any animal or bird, nor remove or have possession of the young of any wild animal or the eggs or nest or young of any bird.
7. No person shall give or attempt to give any animal or bird any noxious substance.
8. No person shall permit or allow any domestic animal to be in a park except when fastened or led by a cord, chain or string not longer than 6 feet.
9. No person shall discharge or cause to be placed in any body of water in or adjacent to a park, any substance that may result in pollution of the water.
10. No person shall bring in or dump, deposit or leave bottles, broken glass, ashes, paper, boxes, cans, dirt, rubbish, waste, garbage or refuse or any other trash. Rubbish and waste resulting from lawful use of the parks shall be placed in proper receptacles.
11. No person shall drive any vehicle on any area except roads designated for vehicular traffic or parking areas, and at a rate of speed not exceeding 15 miles per hour.
12. No person shall park a vehicle in other than an established or designated parking area. Nor shall he/she leave any vehicle anywhere in the park with one or more wheels chained or the motor set or locked, so the vehicle cannot be moved.
13. No person, except for law enforcement, shall ride a bicycle on other than a road or path designated for that purpose. Nor shall he/she leave a bicycle in any place where other persons may trip over or be injured by it.
14. No person shall use, carry or possess firearms of any description (including BB guns, bow and arrows, and slingshots), except as a part of planned and supervised recreational activity approved by the city manager.
15. No person shall picnic or lunch in a place other than that designated for that purpose. Nor shall he/she leave a picnic area before a fire is completely extinguished and before all trash is placed in the disposal receptacles.
16. No person shall camp or set up shacks or any other temporary shelter for the purpose of overnight camping in a public park without prior approval from the city manager.
17. Amplified music is strictly prohibited unless otherwise authorized.
18. No person shall take part in games involving thrown objects such as balls, stones, javelins, and model airplanes, except in areas set apart for such forms of recreation.
19. No person shall solicit alms or contributions for any purpose, whether public or private.
20. No person shall build or attempt to build a fire except in areas designated for that purpose. Nor shall he/she drop, throw or otherwise scatter live matches, burning cigarettes, cigars, tobacco or paper.
21. No public meeting shall be held in any park until permission is obtained from the city manager.
22. No person, unless authorized by the city commission, shall expose or offer for sale any article or thing. Nor shall he/she announce, advertise or call the public attention in any way to any article or service for sale or hire.
